The Method  
Fruit Process Fully de-stemmed  
Yeast: Proprietary "Jayer"  
Extraction: Twice-daily pumpover for three days followed by twice-daily punchdown  
Cuvaion: 26 days  
Elevage: 16 months  
Oak Regimen: French barrels, ~15% new  
Winemaker Notes:

There's a pretty side to the 2021 vintage, and the liveliness that we love about the Eola-Amity Hills comes through decisively in this year's Eola-Amity Hills Cuvée. It has '18's density, but '19's prettiness: It's bright and floral on the nose with an explosive mid-palate and silty texture. Such an expression of the vintage and our beautiful AVA. There's a reason this wine is in our vintage wine club every Spring.
