Winemaker Notes:

The northernmost block at Le Puits Sec continues to produce a wine that is quite distinct from the rest of the Pinot Noir grown on the site. One significant difference is that the La Grive Bleue is all Dijon clones (114 & 115) as opposed to the Pommard-driven Le Puits Sec, but there also seems to be slightly different terroir over there. Of the three Pinot Noir releases this Spring, the La Grive Bleue shows the most vibrancy, restraint and detail.

2021 has the prettiness of '19 or '17 but with plumper fruit and more energy than the '18s. It's a very pretty wine.
