The Method  
Yeast: Native  
Fermentation: Destemmed, crushed, and macerated for three days before moving to barrel.  
Malolactic Conversion: Indigenous & complete  
Elevage: 8 months, raked to blending tank  
Oak Regimen: neutral Francois Frere barrels

## Winemaker Notes:

This is sourced from Torres Bros. Vineyard, our new vineyard located outside of Dallas, OR in the foothills of the Coastal Range. We macerate the skins for three days before pressing to neutral French barrels for fermentation and aging.

This is a leaner edition than our '21s with brighter fruit and great texture. We call it a rosé but depending on your audience you could get away with calling it orange.
